

Dear neighbour,

KiwiRail will be undertaking various works inside the Britomart Tunnel and Waitematā Station during the Christmas shut down period.

During this time, there will be a 24/7 road closure from 29 December 2024 to approximately 15 January 2025 on Britomart Place and impacting parts of Scene Lane at times.

Traffic management will be in place throughout the road closure, so please follow all posted signage and traffic management personnel onsite. Access for residents, and to the parking building will remain throughout this time.

Please exercise caution in this area, as there will be an increased presence of machinery and trucks. Please note that concrete trucks for these works will be accessing the site via Quay Street and Britomart Place and not travelling through Scene Lane.

Wherever we can, we aim to minimise disruption by planning the noisier work for during the daytime. Our staff and contractors are mindful of our rail neighbours and will work hard to minimise any disturbance to get this essential work done.

We are currently delivering stages 4-6 of the C9 (contract 9) City Rail Link's package of works. This involves completing track, overhead line realignments and signaling improvements on the eastern approaches of the Britomart Tunnel.

These are critical to prepare Waitematā Station to handle the increased rail traffic, higher speed trains and enable the future installation of nine-car train lengths on all four plaforms ahead of the City Rail Link opening with Waitematā set to become a through station.
