About the Role

Purpose of the role

KiwiRail is in a phase of significant transformation to modernise and grow our rail and Interislander ferry services in Aotearoa.

The primary purpose of this role is to maintain and repair the locomotive and wagon fleet, along with other associated vehicles as required. This role emphasizes performing maintenance checks outlined in the Rail Operating Code to improve the fleet's reliability and availability.

As a hands-on position, you will collaborate closely with mechanical engineers, locomotive maintainers, train examiners, and servicing assistants in a collaborative, team-focused environment. This position will involve shift work, which will require you to operate on a 24/7 rotating roaster.

Health and Safety is a cornerstone of KiwiRail's operations. In this role, you will function as a proactive safety leader, consistently demonstrating and promoting best safety practices.

Key Accountabilities

Within the area of responsibility, this role is required to:

- · Assist with scheduled maintenance, out-of-course repairs, and incident recovery
- Train in safe and effective engineering practices
- Maintain thorough records to ensure accurate documentation and reporting
- · Help train operators on daily checks and safe equipment use
- Prioritise good housekeeping for a safe and tidy workspace

Operational Responsibilities

- **Support Tradespeople:** Assist qualified tradesmen and Team Leaders in completing tasks safely, on time, and to required quality standards
- Maintenance & Repairs: Under supervision, perform maintenance and repairs on passenger cars, locomotives, and associated vehicles, including Scheduled checks, out-of-course repairs, provisioning, servicing, and incident recovery
- **Execution & Standards:** Safely service and maintain assets to meet KPIs, using sound engineering practices and adhering to safety standards
- Routine Work: Conduct maintenance as per schedule and train operators in safe equipment use and daily checks
- Documentation: Maintain accurate records and provide quality documentation to internal and external customers
- Asset Security & Scope: Ensure the security of customer equipment, operate within competency limits, and understand job requirements
- Health & Safety: Maintain a clean and safe work environment, including housekeeping and additional maintenance tasks as required

Physical demands and the nature of work

This role is physically demanding and requires:

- Extended periods of standing and walking while performing manual tasks
- Regular lifting and carrying of items weighing up to 20 kg independently
- Occasional lifting of items up to 45 kg with assistance or lifting aids
- Working in various weather conditions and environments
- Exposure to mechanical equipment, electrical systems, vibration, fumes, dust, and noise
- Ability to work in confined spaces and at heights using ladders/lifts
- Capability to respond to emergency callouts and work extended shifts
- Manual dexterity and hand-eye coordination for operating tools/equipment
- Protective equipment usage including safety boots, hard hats, eye/ear protection
