The Engine room rating is a walk on walk off position reporting to the Chief Engineer and is responsible for assisting with cleaning and painting in the Engine Room spaces. While working on the vessel the Engine Room Wiper will be allocated work and be directed by the First Officer Engineer.

Key Accountabilities

Operational Responsibilities

- Assist Motormen with cleaning and painting as directed by the First Engineer.
- Report defects and damage identified in the course of their duties.
- In an emergency carry out duties as assigned by the First Engineering Officer

Statutory requirements and Compliance

- Must be familiar with and regularly review the Chief Engineers standing orders and the company's SMS system.
- Comply with all statutory requirements of the vessel.
- Maintains record keeping as required.

Zero Harm

- Must follow all instructions relating to safety and compliance
- Demonstrates through personal actions a commitment to high standard of Health and Safety.
- Ensures appropriate PPE is in use when required.













- Ensures employees, contractors and visitors comply with Interislander Health and Safety practices and the specific requirements of the Safety Management System.
- Responsible for the identification, reporting and initial control of any safety or environmental hazard identified within your area.
- Keep up-to-date with all safety bulletins, changes to codes and practices.
- Responsible for complying with the maritime and safety system standards, procedures and statutory requirements within your area of responsibility
- Report any accidents, near accidents or incidents to the First Engineer
- Responsible for your own safety and that of other employees, contractors and visitors within your work environment
