Homai Station level crossings will close on 27 December

We're starting the next stage of works to improve safer access to Homai Station.

What you need to know

From early December

- Improvements to the area around the station will continue, including widened footpaths, lighting and landscaping.
- Between 8 to 12 December and 15 to 19 December trains will not be running from late evening on the Southern Line so we can prepare for the summer upgrade period. Buses will replace trains during these times.

From 27 December

- Homai Station level crossings will close.
- There will be no access to Homai Station from 27 December to 27 January 2025 while the Summer Rail Upgrade takes place. We'll be using this time to replace the existing stairs from Browns Road with a new ramp to access the station.

- There will be some disruption in the Dalgety Drive park and ride while we carry out construction work, please follow the footpath detours and signs. Parking will be limited during this time.
- Bus stop 6105 will temporarily move within the park and ride, next to the Dalgety Drive entry. Rail bus replacement and urban bus service 365 will run to their normal timetables.

From early 2025

- Homai Station reopens, accessible only via the new ramp from Browns Road.
- The bus stop will return to its usual location on 27 January 2025.





Level crossing removal programme

Homai is one of seven level crossings prioritised for removal ahead of the City Rail Link (CRL) opening.

This is part of AT's programme of work with KiwiRail and NZ Transport Agency (NZTA) to enable faster travel times, more train services, fewer transfers between services, and improve safety along our rail network.

Summer rail upgrades

Major upgrades across the rail network are needed to be ready for more frequent, faster and reliable trains coming when City Rail Link opens in 2026.

- From 27 December to 27 January. Full rail network closure. Buses will replace all trains while we upgrade the rail network and improve your journey.
- From 28 January to 2 February most train services will resume however, buses will continue to replace trains between Otahuhu and Homai and Papakura and Pukekohe on the Southern line, and between Otahuhu to Manukau on the Eastern line.
- The full network will reopen on 3 February 2025.
